TOUR COMBINATION YASUNI NATIONAL PARK AND AMAZON RIVER DOLPHIN

ITINERARY 5 DAYS 4 NIGHT

By flight Departure from Quito.- start trip, Also every day Monday, Wednesday and Friday, upon arrival at Coca airport, we pickup you coca airport , and we go Yasuni National Park

By Bus Departure from Quito the Sundays, Tuesdays and Thursdays of every weeks at 23h30 (travel time 7 hours) Arrival to Coca 06h0 approximated Meeting Point in Hotel el Auca at waiting room, starting of tour at 09h00

FIRST DAY .-

We will visit the Cacao Project (duration: 1 hour, approximately) where we will witness the production process, from planting, to harvest and drying, of a variety of products that are made from Ecuadorean Cocoa, which is amongst the finest in the world.

We will reach the shores of the Napo River to board our private canoe that will take us to the community of Indillama in the Yasuni National Park (journey time: 40 minutes), where the community will receive us with a welcome cocktail before showing us to our rooms for the duration of our stay. Each comfortable room is equipped with a private bathroom, towel, toilet paper, soap, mosquito net and balconies with hammocks for resting after walking in the jungle.

After lunch we will take a three-hour walk along the Tapir Trail where we will be able to observe monkeys, birds, insects, amphibians, ants, medicinal plants, bromeliads, and everything else that the jungle has to offer. During the afternoon we will explore the Indillama River in rowboats, which will give us the opportunity to observe charapas (freshwater turtles), birds, monkeys and the dwarf caiman that inhabit the backwaters of the Yasuni National Park. Following this, we will return to the community for dinner.

SECOND DAY.- 06H00 Breakfast, we will board our motorized canoe that will take us to the community of Añangu, we will visit the observation tower, we Climb the 40 m. tall canopy tower where you can see the Amazon Rainforest in all its splendor until your eyes reach to canopy the majestic Amazon , as well as the mountains of the Andes, then we will visit the Parrot and parakeet clay licks, you can see parrots, macaws of different colors, with hopefully a gaggle of wild pig, or the collare pecare species , usually this activity is successful, although the appropriate climate influences

During the afternoon we will visit the community centre to see cultural demonstrations, and where you will be able to buy local handicrafts made by the women of the community with seeds and other natural materials that they collect in the jungle.

At nightfall we will undertake a short walk to see some of the nocturnal animals of the surrounding rainforest, before dining and resting

THIRD DAY. - 06H00, The day begins early, at 06:00, with a walk along the Ceibo Trail to see birds, monkeys, snakes and amphibians. At this time of day, we will have the most favourable conditions for wildlife watching. The walk lasts two hours, after which we will return for breakfast, this activity is conditioned to the rainy weather, the reason we have to approach the fast boat at 09h30 approximately, bound for Nuevo Rocafuerte for activities with the pink dolphin, we will arrive at Nuevo Rocafuerte at 12h00 approximately.

By boat speed sailing through the Napo River to the village of Nuevo Rocafuerte on the border with Peru. Estimated time of travel 3 hours There is a 15-minute stop in the middle of the journey in the small village of Pañacocha, on our arrival we will have lunch and we will change to a motorized canoe that will take us to the Amazonian Delfin habitat on the border with Peru in the Cocaya community, Here we will stay in cabins with private bathrooms, basic constructions built with materials from the jungle, we will go in search of the pink dolphin, you will be able to interact with the pink dolphin, dinner and we will rest for the following day.

FOURTH DAY.- 06 am, we will go to the shores of the Aguarico river in search of the pink dolphin, estimated time of this activity one hour to two hours, this activity will depend on our guests if you require more time with the Amazon river dolphin, after breakfast we will go along the path in search of birds, monkeys, amphibians, reptiles, insects, and what the jungle can offer us, back to lunch we will make a rest, in the afternoon go in search of the pink dolphin this activity is usually successful in 90%, in the afternoon we will also sail through the small river that comes out of the peculiar marshland forest for its waters similar to Tea, in the depths of its dark waters inhabits the infamous piranha of the Amazon, as well as other species of aquatic fishes, we will fish for a moment until the sun goes down and we return in the dark looking at caiman, the black caiman the largest in the Amazon the name cientific melanosuchos niger, end of our activities, Dinner

Note: this itinerary usually has moficaciones since it is necessary to sleep in Nuevo Rocafuerte to board the speed boat that will take us back to the Yasuni National Park please organize with the leader of the tour, the activity of the marshland forest can be done in the First day, we leave to your choice to stay longer with the pink Dolphin

FIFTH DAY .- 7:00 am Breakfast, at 08:00 am We will board the speed boat in Nuevo Rocafuerte that will take us to Francisco de Orellana Coca, arrival to Coca bethween time 12 to 13 - flight to Quito at 17:25 arrival to Quito at 18:00

INCLUDED.-

Starting from Coca .-

tickets speed boat From Coca to Nuevo Rocafuerte, All meals in the Amazon river dolphin and Yasuni National Park Indillama, purified water, room with private bathroom and entry cost into Amazon river dolphin and Yasuni National Park, native guide speak english, rooms with private bathroom equipped with towel, soap, toilet paper, mosquito net, rain poncho, rubber boots (maximum size available is 45), torch and replacement batteries.

NOT INCLUDED.-

Air fares from country of origin and between Quito and Coca. Food during your journey from Quito to Coca and return, breakfast in Coca on the first day or dinner on the last day, lodging in Coca, contribution to the Yasuni National Park Kichwa Women's Project US\$10, or any other activity that is not written in the itinerary

Note: this itinerary may require adjustments due to the rainy weather of the Amazon, as well as the activities in the walks on the trails for the time it takes us to observe the wildlife, so we also do not guarantee sightings of large animals, in this case we can not guarantee the sighting of the pink dolphin, although usually this activity is successful, but in the months of June and July until the middle of August the possibilities of sightings are reduced by 50%
